

Training on Managing Obstetric Emergencies in the Field

Project Summary

Problem

Addresses the gap in skilled care before, during, and after birth that is necessary to save maternal and newborn lives.

Proposed Solution

Assess the impact of training in Advanced Life Support in Obstetrics (ALSO) on staff skills and transfer to clinical practice in the field.



Potential Impact

- Access to skilled care before, during and after birth, which is necessary to save the lives of mothers and newborns
- Leverage learnings to improve staff capacity to address obstetric complications
- Promote L&D, improve patient outcomes

Viability

- Measures training efficacy for pregnancy and peri-natal complications

Risk Mitigation

- Builds upon experience with the Advanced Life Support in Obstetric training

Scalability

- If successful, evaluation approach can be scaled across MSF learnings and contexts
