Problem

MSF has a social responsibility to its patients, staff, and as a global citizen to understand, assess and minimize its environmental footprint.

Proposed Solution

Phase 1 adapted and conducted a proof of concept for an **environmental toolkit** for pilot MSF offices and field sites. Phase 2 will **upgrade and scale the toolkit**, conduct an assessment on **MSF's supply chain** and develop a roadmap to carbon neutrality by adopting best environmental practices appropriate to MSF. Phase 2 will continue to promote the Top 10 areas identified in Phase 1 to mitigate MSF's environmental footprint.



Potential Impact

- Further understanding MSF's environmental impact and top 10 mitigation actions
- Improve patient, staff, donor, citizen and public accountability

Viability

- Leverages lessons learned from Phase 1 and other NGOs and community-based organizations
- Engages expertise in environmental assessment

Risk Mitigation

- Strong executive championship and collaboration
- Focus on clear actionable initiatives

Scalability

- Methodology will be flexible to enable local engagement by sections across MSF
- Methodology will consider methods to automate financial and logistical data
