### Problem

MSF Operations has identified **increased risk exposure of MSF teams in the field** and the need to map and improve intersectional Field Critical Incident Response resources in high risks countries. Cross MSF common knowledge for security in terms of terminology, concepts, and principles is needed.

### Proposed Solution

Develop an **intersectional, all OC's, hybrid e-training system on Critical Incident Response**. Agree on the common, cross-OC training content. **Test** common and targeted-specific modular content **at the project level** with users and feedback incorporated into updated content.



### Potential Impact

- Improves intersectional **Field Critical Incident Response** in high-risk countries
- Focuses on field-based training for staff
- Expands **certified trainers** in the field

### Viability

- Led by **Security Focal Points** from each OC
- Leverages the **TEMBO platform** to share knowledge across the movement

### Risk Mitigation

- Uses a bottom-up approach, training people in the field to test security modules and ensure practical, actionable content

### Scalability

- Supported by **all OC Security Focal Points**
- Improves MSF-wide **cooperation** on security issues
